

STUDY ABROAD “A TASTE OF EUROPE” 2018



Rosen College of Hospitality Management has developed a “Taste of Europe” study abroad program for students interested in visiting Austria, Germany, Switzerland, France, Italy and Monaco, where they will learn the European approach to culinary, beer and wine-making and sourcing of food and beverage products **May 21 – June 6, 2018**.

- Immersion within six different Western European cultures
- Sourcing and tasting of food and beverage products, including pastries, cheeses, pastas, beers, wines, and chocolates)
- Visiting popular sites (Hermannsdorfer Landwerkstatten Organic Farm Complex in Munich; Aeschbach Chocolatier and Cesar Ritz Campus in Lucerne
- Guided tour: Cannes International Film Festival in Niece, France; Italy’s Cinque Terre cliffs and beaches; Switzerland’s Lake Lucerne; and the Alps mountain range.
- Three-day cooking school at the International IFSE in Turin, Italy

Courses will be facilitated at UCF during the early-summer in 2018 to prepare for the geo-political and social differences abroad: European culture, history, customs, cuisine, wines and beers. Classes will involve lectures, discussion, teamwork, and field experience.

Participants in this program register for a total of six credit hours by taking International Gastronomy (HFT 4894) and Culture and Cuisine (FSS 3008).

Basic price for the trip is \$5500

Additional costs (estimated by past students):

- Air Transportation from Orlando to Munich and Barcelona to Orlando (\$900 - 1,300)
- Passport or visa expenses (\$110; visa not required for USA citizens)
- Personal or other misc. expenses (\$200-400)
- Meals other than those listed (\$20-300)
- Overall for trip and additional costs = \$7,200 - \$7500
- Plus UCF Tuition (Florida prepaid does apply to these courses)
