



## WHAT ARE YOU DOING THIS SUMMER?

UCF Rosen College of Hospitality Management is proud to announce its new study abroad program: **“Exploring Entertainment & Events in Europe.”** This program is for students interested in experiencing European entertainment events and festivals and welcomes students in the Entertainment Management degree program as well as students majoring in other related fields. During the program students will attend and study some of the most extraordinary happenings in the world while traveling to **Switzerland, France, England, and Scotland**. The travel portion of this program will run from **July 21 – August 6, 2018**, during which students will:

- Experience four distinct Western European cultures: Nyon and Lucerne, Paris, London and Edinburgh
- Attend world-renowned events and major art, music, and theatrical festivals
- Enjoy additional cultural events and city tours
- Speak directly with organizers of large-scale cultural events



Courses will be run at the Rosen College campus during Summer Session B (late June – early July, 2018) to prepare students for the challenges of traveling and studying abroad, as well as to begin the academic coursework required for this program. We will discuss European culture and customs, and have lectures and coursework requirements in order to maximize the experiential learning that will occur while in Europe.

Basic price for the trip is \$5,400  
Additional costs (estimated by past students):

- Air Transportation from Orlando to Geneva, Edinburgh to Orlando (\$900 - 1,300)
- Passport or visa expenses (\$110; visa not required for USA citizens)
- Personal or other misc. expenses (\$200-400)
- Meals other than those listed (\$20-300)
- Overall for trip and additional costs = \$7,200 - \$7500
- Plus UCF Tuition (Florida prepaid does apply to these courses)
