BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN SENIOR LIVING MANAGEMENT

The senior living management bachelor's degree is an interdisciplinary program that combines hospitality, health management and social work. Senior living management companies have expressed a need for qualified individuals with combined skills in health management and hospitality services, thus the interdisciplinary nature of the degree.

The senior living management program is the first degree program of its kind in the United States to combine the exceptional customer service approach found in hospitality management with an emphasis on establishing a high standard of living for patients by focusing on creating a feeling of home and community.

No medical or nursing degrees are required for this program. The core curriculum focuses on general education, hospitality, healthcare management and senior living lifestyle courses that emphasize lodging, dining, events and entertainment.

The program prepares graduates for professional and leadership positions in independent and assisted living housing as well as continuous care communities.



According to a 2018 Argentum report on senior living labor and workforce trends, job growth in the senior living industry grew by 40 percent in 10 years compared to an average 7 percent for other fields. Of the 892,000 jobs available in this field in 2016, at least 20 percent were managerial positions, such as:
