AGREEMENT TO RULES OF THE KIDS KITCHEN CAMP

In order to make this program a success, it is vital that all campers realize that standards of conduct must be understood and observed. Parents/guardians are requested to go over the following items with their child PRIOR TO the first day of the Kids Kitchen Camp.

I/we agree to observe the following Camp Pineapple Campus Rules:

- 1. Nametag must be worn at all times.
- Campers will wear the required uniform daily: (1) Issued long-sleeve t-shirt M-Th, and chef coat on Friday; (2) Issued cap or hair net (if you have long hair, you will be required to wear both); (3) Apron loaned by the College; (4) Long pants covering over shoes (not tight; no yoga pants/no tights); (5) closetoed, non-slip shoes (not mesh); (5) socks.
- 3. Campers cannot have long nails, nor nail polish. All campers must have clean, short nails as mandated for health and food safety.
- 4. Personal cleanliness is required at all times.
- 5. No gum chewing allowed.
- 6. Hair is always under control, in a hat or hair net, or both.
- 7. Boys must be clean shaven, or wear a beard guard.
- 8. Campers must never be alone outside of sessions. Unless given permission otherwise, all campers must stay with their assigned buildings/rooms and be supervised by their instructors, camp counselors, or a member of the Kids Kitchen Camp staff.
- 9. Campers are not allowed to re-enter personal vehicles once camp begins each day, until dismissal time as picked up by the designated parent or guardian.
- 10. Cell phone/electronic devices may only be used during the approved time of day, if necessary. These devices will be turned off at all other times.
- 11. Respect the personal property of others at the Kids Kitchen Camp.
- 12. Be respectful of UCF Rosen property and inform a staff member if anything is damaged.
- 13. Use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal substances will not be tolerated. Any items found will be confiscated and the participant's parents/legal guardians will be contacted and the participant will be sent home.
- 14. Possession of firearms or other weapons will not be tolerated. Any items found will be confiscated and the participant's parents/legal guardians will be contacted along with appropriate authorities, and the participant will be sent home.
- 15. Observe the camp schedule, including session times and other activities.

- 16. Campers will follow instructions in the lab and only touch equipment and utensils as instructed by chef instructors and assistance.
- 17. Cooperate with faculty, professionals, teachers, and group leaders at all times.
- 18. Participate in **all** activities.
- 19. Stay safe and always follow directions.
- 20. Be polite and respectful to everyone. UCF Rosen College and the Kids Kitchen Camp do not tolerate bullying of any kind including teasing of counselors and campers. You will be sent home if deemed necessary. We promote diversity and inclusion and want everyone to feel welcome.

If there is a violation of these Kids Kitchen Camp rules, participants' parents/legal guardians may be contacted to have their participant sent home at their expense, as determined by UCF, at UCF's sole discretion.
