### **INTERNSHIPS FOR STUDENTS GRADUATING IN SUMMER 2020 ONLY**

**Question:** I am graduating in Summer 2020, and I need to take Internship III. What do I do?

**Answer:** If you are graduating in the Summer 2020 semester and need to take Internship III in order to graduate on-time, YES, please enroll in the course.

**Question:** I don't have a job/position yet, should I still enroll in the internship course?

**Answer:** Yes, even if you DO NOT have a job/internship you may enroll in the course if you need it to graduate in Summer 2020.

**Question:** I cannot find a job, what do I do?

### **INTERNSHIPS FOR STUDENTS GRADUATING IN FALL 2020 ONLY**

**Answer:** If you are graduating the Fall 2020 semester and need to take Internship II in summer and III in the Fall in order to graduate on-time, YES, please enroll in the course.

**Answer:** Yes, even if you DO NOT have a job/internship you may enroll in the course if you need it to graduate in Summer 2020.

**Question:** I cannot find a job, what do I do?

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR SPRING 2021 INTERNSHIPS \*\*CURRENT ROSEN COLLEGE STUDENTS ONLY**

### **INTERNSHIPS FOR STUDENTS GRADUATING IN SPRING 2021 ONLY**

**Question:** I am graduating in Spring 2021. I have not yet taken any of my internships. I need to take Internship I in Summer 2020, Internship II over the Fall 2020 semester, and Internship III in the Spring 2021 semester. What do I do?

**Answer:** If you are graduating the Spring 2021 semester and need to take Internship I in Summer 2020 order to graduate on-time, YES, please enroll in the course.

**Question:** I don't have a job/position yet, should I still enroll in the internship course?

**Answer:** You do NOT need a job/internship in order to enroll in the Internship I course. No verification of hours is required.

**Question:** I do not graduate until Summer 2021 or later, can I enroll in the Summer 2020 Internship I class?

**Answer:** NO. We are supporting only students who need an internship to graduate for the Summer 2020.

**Question:** I have a job for Summer 2020, can I enroll in the internship course even if I don't graduate until Spring 2023?

**Answer:** At the moment, we are asking all students who have **MORE THAN THREE SEMESTERS BEFORE GRADUATING**, to delay taking Internship I until the Fall 2020 semester. You will not be penalized with your hours and will be able to use them in the future semester.
