One of the things that UCF Rosen College did when it was evident that we would no longer be able to gather to share professional development opportunities, was to create the webinar series, <u>Research, Recovery & Reskill</u>, aimed at our 12,000 plus alumni. This webinar series also appealed to students and industry partners, who were finding that the world of hospitality had changed and they needed to beef up their resumes and adjust their perspectives. There are currently 14 Research Recovery & Reskill webinars available on the YouTube channel. Within the 14 webinars is a four-part series, produced in partnership with UCF Restores, a clinic specializing in the treatment of trauma, that is housed in the College of Sciences at the University of Central Florida. UCF Restores has developed many programs to rapidly respond to community health issues as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic crisis.



Among the YouTube webinar offerings you will also find a series of industry-aimed webinars <u>Research, Recovery & Rescaling</u>, This series focused on current research conducted through the Dick Pope Sr. Institute for Tourism Studies, housed here at Rosen College. The five-part webinar series discussed tourism trends, travel expectations, resiliency and what to expect in the future.

The newest offerings on the Rosen College YouTube Channel are the <u>Dean's Distinguished Lecture Series</u>. To honor Dr. Abraham Pizam, founding dean of UCF Rosen College of Hospitality Management on the 50th anniversary of his achieving his Ph.D., the Dean's Distinguished Lecture Series looked at the evolution of the hospitality and tourism industry through the eyes of some of the pioneers in this field of education.
