About the Program

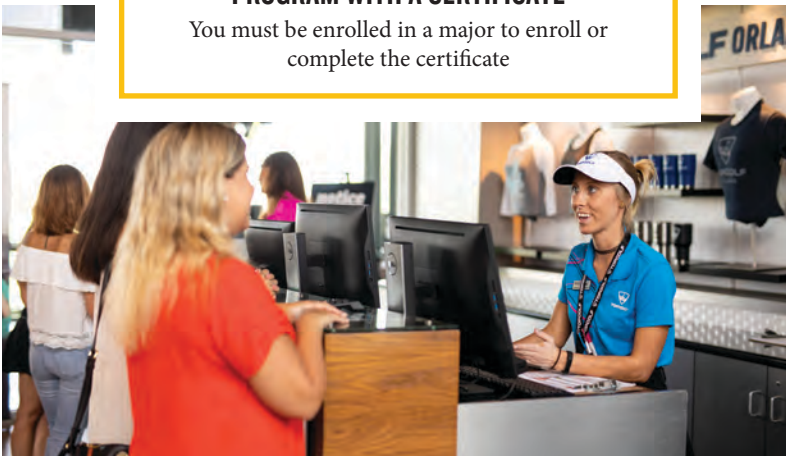
The Graduate Certificate in Destination Marketing & Management provides knowledge and information that facilitates the effective marketing and management of tourist destinations.

- Available fully online
- Required Courses—9 Credit Hours
- Complete in 3 to 12 months
- In-state tuition applies for Florida residents

This certificate covers the strategies for creating integrated destination marketing and management systems, critically reviews those issues and techniques of international tourism management with a particular focus on the economic, socio-cultural, and environmental impacts of tourist development at destinations, and analyzes the quantitative impact of tourism as an industry both within and beyond tourist destinations. Students learn to synthesize theory and application at the graduate level in order to produce the knowledge base necessary to fully utilize available techniques and strategies for the effective marketing and management of tourist destinations.

Required Courses: 9 hours (3 courses, all are 3 credit hours)

General Information on Graduate Certificates

- Each Graduate Certificate is comprised of three required courses, nine credit hours in total. These credits from the graduate certificate can be transferred toward our Master of Science in Hospitality and Tourism Management degree.
- (1) individuals who have previously completed bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degrees, and (2) students currently admitted to our graduate degree programs are eligible to enroll in certificate programs.
- There is no specific course sequence in that a number of sections of each course are available throughout the year. One course, and sometimes more, are offered each term.

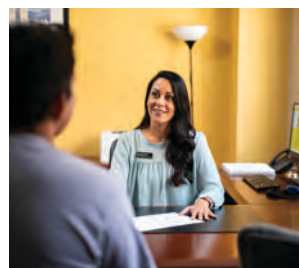
