Curriculum

- You can complete your degree either fully online, face-to-face, or customize it through a mix of both to fit your schedule and budget, although the thesis option is not available to students who study fully online.
- The Hospitality and Tourism Management MS program requires a minimum of 33 credit hours for students who choose the thesis option or non-thesis option. For both options, 18 credit hours are required core courses.
- We currently have more than 40 graduate courses in a wide range of topics, including social media and digital marketing, events, theme parks, supply chain management, entrepreneurship, and leadership and strategy.
- The non-thesis option is the most popular program and is intended for students who anticipate a managerial and leadership position in the hospitality and tourism industry.
- The thesis option is intended for students interested in scientific study and may anticipate pursuing a doctoral degree or a professional research position.
- Students currently admitted to a graduate degree program can apply and enroll in graduate certificate programs. Each Graduate Certificate is comprised of three required courses, nine credits in total. These credits from the graduate certificate can be transferred toward our Master of Science in Hospitality and Tourism Management degree.

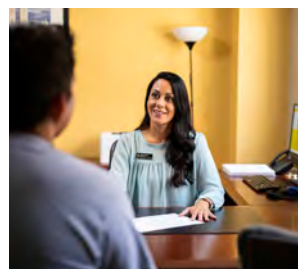

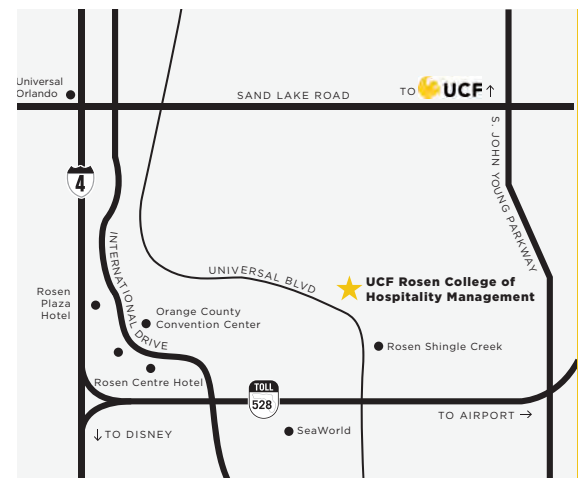
