Andrew Zimmern Second Chances Scholarship

Applicants must:

- + Submit an ESSAY (of 250 words) describing extreme challenges (health, family, military, employment, etc.) faced and explain how this scholarship in culinary studies will give them the 'second chance' deserved in overcoming these hardships.

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$10,000 will be granted

Bentonville Culinary (The Hive 21c)

Sponsored by Bentonville Chefs, Bentonville, AR

Preference will be given to applicants residing in or attending school in the state of Arkansas.

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$4,250 will be granted

Bern Laxer Memorial Scholarship

Sponsored by Bern's Steak House and Epicurean Hotel, Tampa, FL

Applicants must:

- + Be a substantiated resident of the state of Florida
- + Have at least one year of culinary experience, either as a student or employee
- + Major in culinary studies, hospitality management or viticulture/oenology

Up to two (2) scholarships of \$10,000 will be granted

The JBF Caviar Chefs of Tomorrow Scholarship Fund

Sponsored by Caviar

Applicants must:

- + Identify as BIPOC
- + Be planning to pursue culinary or pastry at an accredited institution
- + Reside in the United States

Up to two (2) scholarships of \$20,000 will be granted

Debbie Lewis Women in Wine Scholarship

The Debbie Lewis Women in Wine Scholarship honors the life of Debbie Lewis. Debbie had a life-long passion for mastering the business of wine and set an inspiring example of dedication and hard work to all those around her.

Applicants must:

- + Be at least 21 years of age
- + Be woman-identifying
- + Be a current resident of the United States
- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a beverage, wine studies, or hospitality management program or a master sommelier program at an accredited culinary school, hospitality institution, college, or university

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$5,000 will be granted

École Ducasse Scholarship

Applicants must:

- + Be at least 18 years of age by the start of the program
- + Have a high school diploma
- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a diploma, signature or bachelor program at École Ducasse, Paris, or École Ducasse, Yssingeaux, France
- + Submit a 400-500 word essay on: how I believe studying a culinary or pastry program in France will impact my career
- + Be from North or South America

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$3,000 and one (1) scholarship of \$2,000 will be granted

Fulton Youth of the Future at the Robert Fulton Houses Scholarship

Sponsored by Jamestown Properties, NYC

Applicants must:

- + Be a substantiated resident of the Robert Fulton Houses in Chelsea
- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a program of study for culinary arts, wine, food history, nutrition, dietetics, continuing education, food writing, or related field

Applicants must:

- + Provide two letters of recommendation from instructors or employers
- + Indicate which of the following regions in which they reside
 - California (CA)
 - Great Lakes (IL, IN, MI, OH)
 - Mid-Atlantic (DC, DE, MD, NJ, PA, VA)
 - Midwest (IA, KS, MN, MO, NE, ND, SD, WI)
 - Mountain (CO, ID, MT, UT, WY)
 - New York State (NY)
 - Northeast (CT, MA, ME, NH, RI, VT)
 - Northwest & Pacific (AK, HI, OR, WA)
 - South (AL, AR, FL, LA, MI, PR)
 - Southeast (GA, KY, NC, SC, TN, WV)
 - Southwest (AZ, NM, NV, OK)
 - Texas (TX)

Up to twelve (12) scholarships of \$20,000 each will be granted to one person per designated region

Mildred Amico Scholarship

Applicants must:

- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled (part-time or full-time) in the hospitality management program at New York City College of Technology (two- or four-year program).

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$2,900 each will be granted

Miljenko “Mike” Grgich’s American Dream Scholarship

Sponsored by Grgich Hills Estate, Rutherford, CA

Applicants must:

- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a wine studies program

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$5,000 will be granted

The JBF Mondelēz International Scholarship Fund for Equity in Leadership

Applicants must:

- + Women-identifying or BIPOC
- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled at an accredited institution, focusing on culinary arts, pastry and baking, culinary science, or food business
- + Reside in the United States

Up to three (3) scholarships of \$10,000 each will be granted

OpenTable “Cultivating Talent” Scholarship

Based in San Francisco, OpenTable has been committed to helping restaurants run and grow their businesses since 1998. Through this scholarship, they are working with San Francisco Cooking School to help train and grow the next generation of Bay Area chefs.

Applicants must:

- + Be accepted into the Culinary Arts Certificate program at San Francisco Cooking School (SFCS)
- + Demonstrate financial need
- + Agree to extern with one of OpenTable’s partner restaurants as part of the SFCS externship program

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$5,000 will be granted

Patrick Clark Memorial Scholarship

Sponsored by the Brown Family

Applicants must:

- + Be a substantiated resident of the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, or Staten Island NYC borough
- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in the two- or four-year hospitality management program at New York City College of Technology

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$4,000 will be granted

Peter Kump Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must:

- + Be a high school senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- + Be planning to enroll at a licensed or accredited culinary school
- + Have a minimum of one year of substantiated experience in the culinary field
- + Demonstrate financial need

Up to two (2) scholarships of \$10,000 will be granted

Robert Mondavi Winery Memorial Scholarship

Sponsored by Robert Mondavi Winery, Oakville, CA

Applicants must:

- + Be a United States resident
- + Be over 21 years of age
- + Have a high school diploma or GED
- + Be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a beverage, wine studies, or hospitality management program or a master sommelier program at an accredited culinary school, hospitality institution, college, or university

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$10,000 will be granted

San Francisco Cooking School Scholarship

Applicants must:

- + Be accepted into the Culinary Arts Certificate program at San Francisco Cooking School
- + Demonstrate financial need

Up to one (1) scholarship of \$10,000 will be granted

Wilson Daniels Wine Education Scholarship

This scholarship grants two applicants the chance to further their wine education with a \$2,500 subsidy towards their studies with the Wine & Spirits Education Trust (WSET) or the International Wine Center (IWC).

Applicants must:

- + Reside in the United States
- + Be at least 21 years of age
- + Open to current and aspiring beverage professionals and those who have a deep interest and appreciation for wine and continuing their wine education
- + Have applied for a specific course/exam with WSET or IWC. If your indicated exam is canceled or postponed due to COVID-19, you will still be eligible to receive scholarship funds, provided that we can verify your application/eligibility
- + Recipients for financial aid will be selected based on demonstration of need and merit.

Up to two (2) scholarship of \$2,500 will be granted.

Jean-Louis Palladin Professional Work/Study Grant

Chef Jean-Louis Palladin is considered one of the culinary geniuses of the 20th century. He was a master of his craft, known for his creativity, passion, technique, and commitment to the very best. Jean-Louis was as much a teacher as a chef, encouraging and mentoring many while demanding perfection of himself and all around him. He was funny, laughed easily, and embraced life fully.

The James Beard Foundation is proud to offer the Jean-Louis Palladin Professional Work/Study Grant. Created to perpetuate the mission and programs of the Jean-Louis Palladin Foundation, the initiative will provide two annual grants up to \$4,000 to working chefs.

You must submit your own work/study plan alongside a detailed budget.

Required materials:

- + An up-to-date cover letter
- + Two professional references
- + A detailed work/study plan

Please note:

- + Funding is sent *after* the program via reimbursement
- + Detailed expense forms and final narrative reports will be required for all accepted applicants (view examples [here](#))
- + Reimbursement is contingent on the timely submission of the above documents

Tuition *Waivers*

Institute of Culinary Education

Up to three (3) waivers will be granted toward tuition for the following programs:

- + Up to one (1) waiver of \$3,500 for the culinary arts, health supportive culinary arts or pastry and baking arts diploma programs
- + Up to one (1) waiver of \$2,500 for the sommelier program
- + Up to one (1) waiver of \$2,500 for the diploma in restaurant and culinary management or the hospitality and hotel management programs.
- + Awards are available year-round (all program durations are between 6-11 months and commence monthly)

Applicants must:

- + Be between the ages of 19-25
- + Be planning to enroll as entering freshman (not currently enrolled) at the Institute of Culinary Education
- + Have been admitted into the Institute of Culinary Education

Johnson & Wales University

Up to one (1) waiver of \$3,000 will be granted toward tuition at Johnson & Wales University campus in Providence or Charlotte, NC. The award is renewable up to four additional years (for a total of \$12,000). To remain eligible for the award, the student must maintain satisfactory academic performance.

Applicants must:

- + Be 18 years of age or older
- + Have a high school diploma or equivalent speak fluent English and/or French language
- + Motivation for bakery and culinary world
- + Have a professional project in the culinary business
- + Must be accepted to Johnson & Wales University full-time undergraduate program
