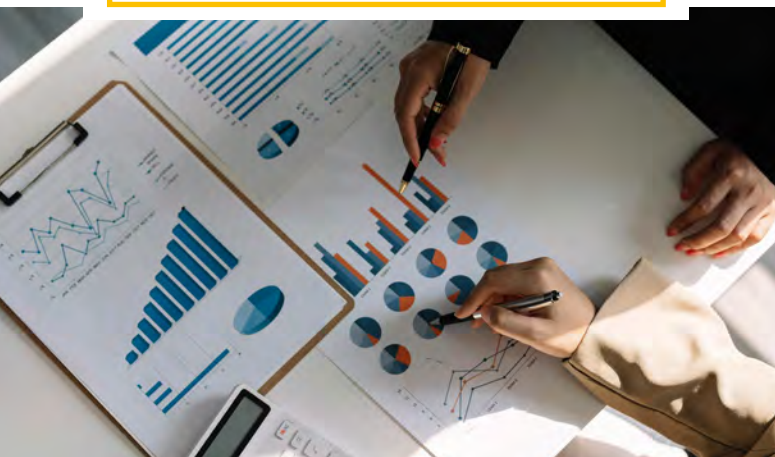
About the Program

The Graduate Certificate in Financial Management for the Hospitality and Tourism Industry provides knowledge and information that facilitates the effective financial management of hospitality and tourism entities.

- Required Courses—9 Credit Hours
- Complete in 3 to 12 months
- In-state tuition applies for Florida residents

The certificate covers the strategies for creating value for stakeholders within and for an organization and critically reviews performance metrics with a focus on the economic, business, and financial risk factors that may impact entity performance. Students learn to synthesize theory and application at the graduate level in order to produce the knowledge base necessary to fully utilize available techniques and strategies for the effective financial management of hospitality and tourism organizations. Students successfully completing this certificate may already be in financial analyst or accounting/finance roles or seeking such roles in this particular field.

- HMG6466 - Applied Revenue Management Techniques in Hospitality

General Information on Graduate Certificates

- Each Graduate Certificate is comprised of three required courses, nine credit hours in total. These credits from the graduate certificate can be transferred toward our Master of Science in Hospitality and Tourism Management degree.
- (1) individuals who have previously completed bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degrees, and (2) students currently admitted to our graduate degree programs are eligible to enroll in certificate programs.
- There is no specific course sequence in that a number of sections of each course are available throughout the year. One course, and sometimes more, are offered each term.

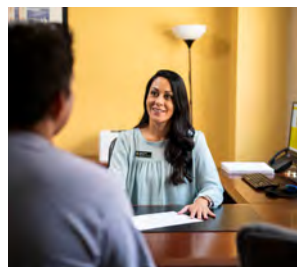
