## We Know Lifestyle Community Management

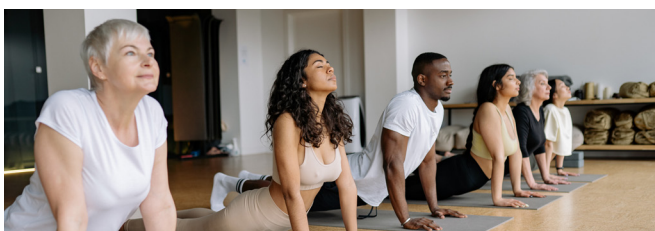

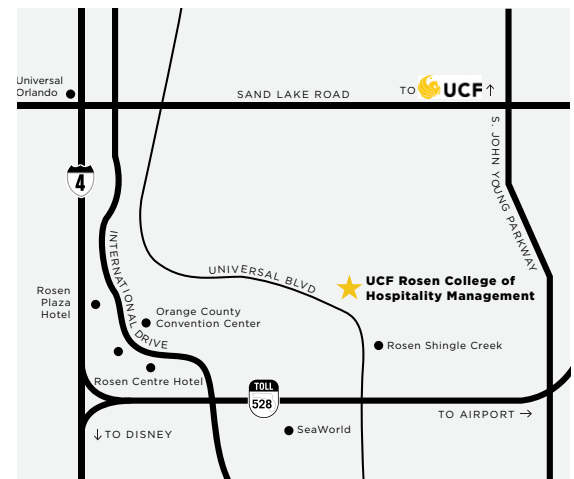
