## Requirements

## I5 total semester hours with minimum grade and average

 GPA requirements:- 9 hours required courses, 6 hours restricted electives
- No course grade lower than a C will be accepted for the
- certificate requirements
- The average GPA for the four courses must be 3.00 and higher
- At least 12 credit hours used towards the certificate must be earned at UCF
- For courses with a tasting component (C-designation): Minimum age 18 on first day of class

- HFT 4065C (M) or HFT 4065 (W) Fine Spirits Management
- HFT 4866C (M) or HFT 4866 (W) Exploring Wines of the World


## Restricted Electives: 6 hours ( 2 courses, all options are 3 credit hours) <br> Students select two additional courses from the following:

- HFT 3811 (W) Beverage Sales, Marketing, and Distribution
- HFT 3068 (W) History and Culture of Beer
- HFT 3868C (M) History and Culture of Wine
- HFT 4864C (M) Seminar in Quality Brewing and Fine Beer
- HFT 4865C (M) Advanced Wine Management (Prerequisite: HFT 4866 or HFT 4866C)
